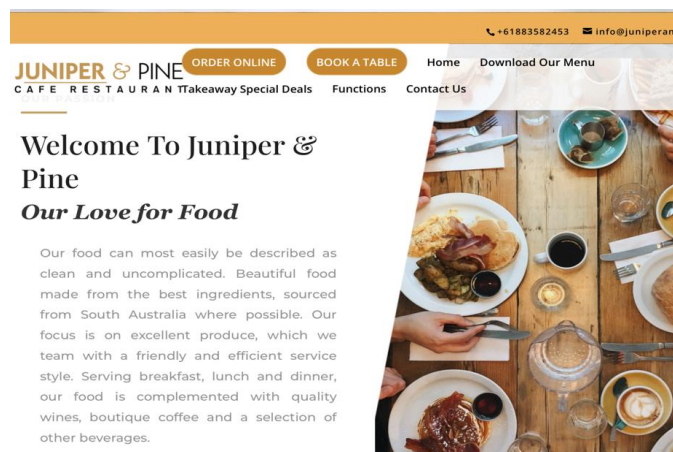

EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN

ACTIONS TO TAKE IF A FIRE IS DISCOVERED

Warn occupants in the immediate area (by ringing the bell) – both inside and outside the clubrooms.

The Warden at the time of the emergency is the Safety Officer.

The Safety Officer at the time of emergency should wear a high-vis vest. (*Attendees need to know who to follow instructions from.*)

Firefighting should only be attempted if someone is trained in the use of firefighting equipment, the fire is small enough to contain and you are not putting yourself or anyone else at risk.

Open the right hand door at the northern side of the clubrooms immediately to allow quicker evacuation.

Evacuate the building immediately.

The key on the right of the storage room next to the kitchen should be taken to unlock the evacuation area gates.

Move to a safe place outside to call Emergency Services and confirm to a Committee member that the call has been made. Provide Emergency Services with a clear description of the Club's location, including the nearest intersection and the nature of the emergency, eg a fire in the clubrooms.

Check the office, toilets and kitchen areas. This can be done by a Committee member or someone appointed at the time by the Safety Officer.

Ask everyone to exit through the double doors on the northern side of the clubrooms and move straight across to the fence. Ask members to then walk around the edge of the fence/lawns heading west, then turning east, exiting through the double gates in the fence where the Emergency Evacuation Area is signed. Everyone should move away from the croquet area, through the carpark and onto the oval used for rugby games.

Note: The area both inside and outside of the double doors in the clubroom should be clear at all times, but especially when there is an event with a large number of people. Inside tables and chairs should not be placed near these doors so as to obstruct an emergency exit.

It is not practical for a small sporting club to have a Fire Warden so the Safety Officer will be in charge of the evacuation, liaising with any attending Committee members at the time.

Take precautions to avoid fires starting by:

- . Checking that electrical items have been tested for safety
- . Unplug all electrical items when leaving the clubrooms
- . Ensure that the key to the gates to the evacuation area is hanging on the wall on the right in the storage room at all times
- . Ensure that the Kitchen fire blanket can be easily located.
